Scholarships for international PhD students who are in the concluding stage of their doctorate

Dear PhD students,

31.01.2020

- Are you doing a PhD at the University of Bamberg?
- Are you currently in the concluding stage of your doctorate and will you presumably finish your PhD thesis by 31st December 2020?
- Are you a non-German national?
- Do you not receive any other scholarship and do you not have any other income from a job or employment?

If you have answered all above questions with „yes“, you are eligible to apply for a special scholarship for the concluding stage of your PhD.

These scholarships are financed by the DAAD STIBET-Doktorandenprogramm. The monthly rate of a full scholarship is **750 Euro** and can be awarded for a maximum duration of **4 months**. Recipients will be selected by a cross-faculty committee summoned by the International Office. The selection will be based on academic qualification and in case of equal qualification on social factors.

You will find an application checklist below. The application deadline is **28th February 2020**. Application documents for a DAAD STIBET PhD scholarship:

1. Short cover letter in which you summarize your PhD project, describe the reasons for your application and indicate for how many scholarship months you wish to apply (max. 1 page)
2. Schedule covering the time from January 2020 up to the conclusion of your doctorate (in tabular form, one table per month)
3. Curriculum vitae including a short overview of your previous academic achievements and a table regarding the financing of your PhD so far (e.g. scholarships, salaries, self-finance)
4. Recent reference letter by your PhD supervisor (approx. 1 page)
